### **Short**

Born in Lanciano (Italy) in 1984 from Italian father and Belgian mother, **SARAH RULLI** is an eclectic, creative and innovative musician. From classical to *tango nuevo*, from Baroque to contemporary music, her performances are rich of expression, personality and elegance, and her style is always unique.

To this day she has performed in Italy, Germany, Austria, Belgium, Portugal, Romania, Armenia, Georgia, USA, North Carolina, China and South Korea, playing on important stages like Carnegie Hall and United Nations Palace (New York), Sala Nervi (Vatican), 2015 EXPO in Milan, Emilia Romagna Festival, Palladium Theatre in Rome.

In 2015 her first CD, "*Dreams, Love & Tango*", was released in collaboration with Accordion Quintet Torrefranca. The program is dedicated to Astor Piazzolla and includes some famous movie soundtracks by Zimmer, Mancini and Buonvino.

Many composers – like Martin Palmeri, Enrico Blatti, Roberto Di marino, Alessandro Cusatelli, Fabio Conocchiella – dedicated works to her, both solo or chamber music.

She regularly performs in Italy and abroad. Year 2019 started with two very important concerts as a soloist with orchestra at Sala Verdi in Milan and in Taranto with Orchestra della Magna Grecia.

She teaches flute and creative music pedagogy in Rome, Brussels and Lanciano (IT).
